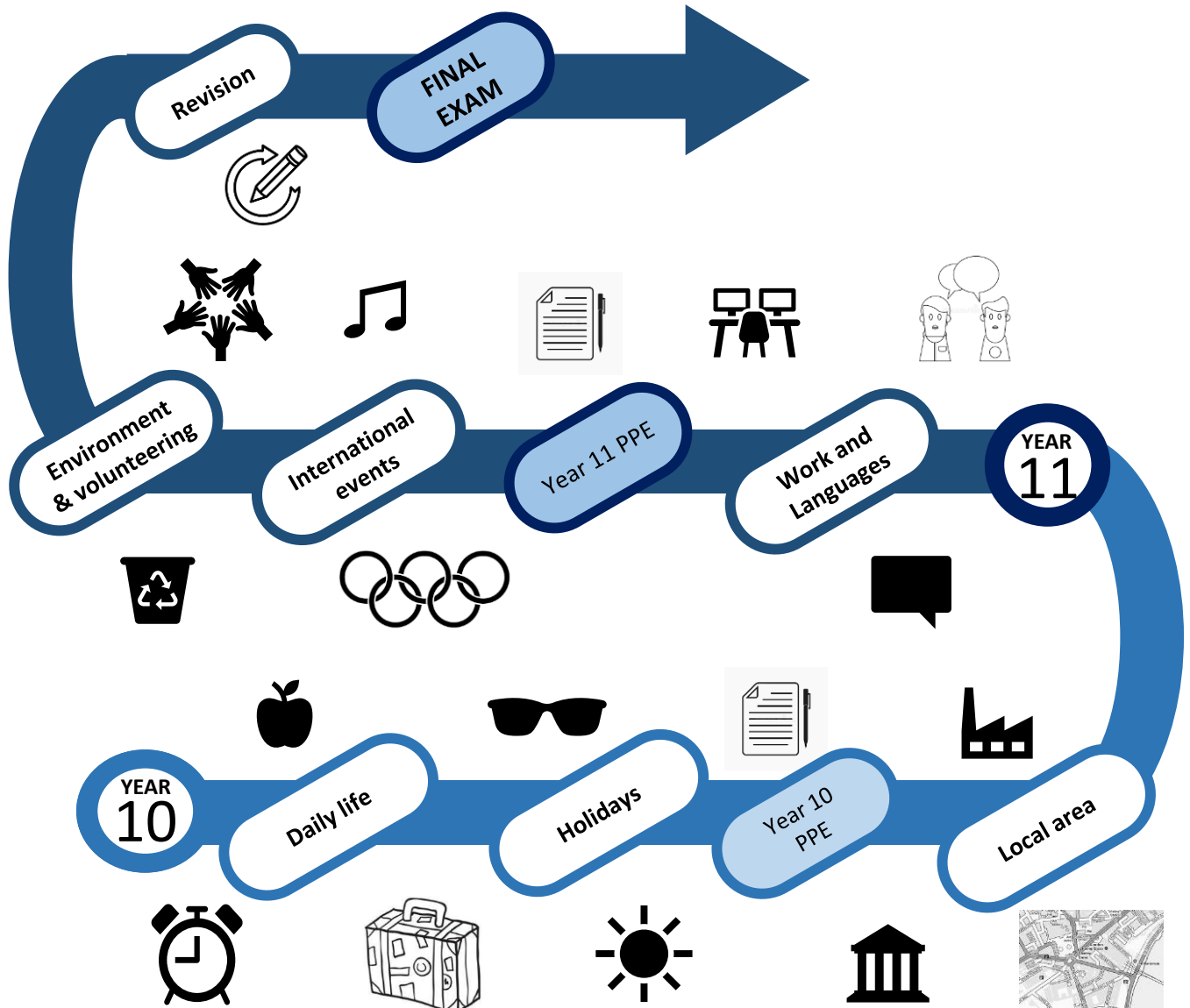
All students
