Clubs - Sign up

How does my child sign up for a club?

New to this year, all students wanting to attend a club **must** express their interest in advance, before they can attend.

Students will be sent a survey to their emails. They must complete this survey by the stated deadline to avoid disappointment.

If a club becomes oversubscribed, a ballot will take place to random select the successful students.

A club survey will be sent every 2 terms, to allow for new students to attend and try new clubs. Please see breakdown below:

Can my child join a club mid term?
