The above visit is being organised by Geography department to fulfil the requirements of the GCSE specification asking students to undertake two days of fieldwork, one of which has already been completed in Ashford. The purpose of the trip is for students to learn a wide range of physical fieldwork techniques and collect data that can be analysed ready for their summer examinations. During the day students will be working in small groups under the direct supervision of two members of staff. Students will be not be required to wear full school uniform but need to dress accordingly for the weather conditions on the day. A packed lunch will also be required.

In accordance with the School's Charging Policy, parents/carers are invited to make a voluntary contribution (details above) towards the cost of the trip. This includes the cost of travel. If you are unable to pay online, payment can be made by cheque or cash. All reply slips and cash/cheque contributions should be returned in a sealed envelope to Student Reception. Envelopes containing cheques can be deposited in the drop box, however, cash payments must be made in person by your son/daughter to the Student Receptionist. No responsibility can be taken for envelopes lost because they are not handed over at the earliest opportunity. Please be advised that if there is insufficient interest in the trip, the trip will not run and a refund will be given. Should the trip have to be cancelled for reasons beyond the school's control, including industrial action by outside agencies or adverse weather conditions, refunds will only be made in so far as the School can claim reimbursement. Should your son/daughter withdraw voluntarily or have to be withdrawn from the trip, and the school has incurred prior costs, monies already paid will not be refunded.
