Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to remind you of the plan for study leave and Year 13's last formal day in school, which will be Friday 17th May.

As you may be aware the examinations this year start on Monday 13th May. However, there are only a few students involved in the first couple of examinations. If your son/daughter does have an examination prior to study leaving starting they are permitted to take the morning off prior to an afternoon examination, otherwise they should attend all lessons as normal. Official study leave for all of Year 13 will start from Monday 20th May.

On Friday 17th May, there will be a leaver's assembly in the hall. The celebrations will commence at 8.30 am with pastries and snacks. Year 13 teachers will be invited along to this to wish the whole year the best in their forthcoming examinations. The assembly will then begin at 9.00 am. At the end of assembly, around 10.30, students will be expected to leave the school site. Students are not required to come into school in full uniform, however, they must ensure what they wear is appropriate for a school environment. Students should also leave their bags at home as they will not need them for this event.

Although the 17th May is Year 13's last compulsory day at school their teachers will still be available during their normal lesson times to help and support them with their revision. I would suggest that every member of Year 13 take full advantage of this.

On Wednesday 26th June we are holding our book return day, therefore students must ensure they come back into school with their books, ID badges and locker keys and complete the documentation essential for the return of their £50 deposit.

I am sure that you are aware that A Level results day is on Thursday 15th August and students will be able to collect their results from 9am on the day. Prior to collecting their results they will need to complete a destination survey that can be accessed from 8.30am in the main reception.

On behalf of all the staff and students in the school, I would also like to take this opportunity once again to wish your son/daughter all the very best in their forthcoming examinations.
