As part of their GCSE course, Geography students have to complete two fieldwork activities. As part of this students will be completing data collection across Ashford town centre and working with this information in subsequent lessons. During the fieldwork students will be working in small groups which requires remote supervision. Students will be required to wear full school uniform. They will need a clipboard and a camera (a camera phone would be acceptable). There is no charge for this trip.

As students will be returning to school by 11:15, they do not require a different lunch to their usual arrangements, although they do need to be aware that they may not get an opportunity to purchase food at break time.

Students can either make their own way to Ashford town centre to meet staff at 9am opposite the entrance to Park Mall and Cex or walk from school with a member of staff leaving at 8:30 promptly. All students will be accompanied back to school at the end of the fieldwork activity.

Students should return the completed permission slip and medical form to their Geography teacher and NOT to student reception on this occasion.
